## **Session 2 Focus: Responding to the Gospel**

Read Luke Chapter 4 and revisit our discussion of this chapter with the questions below.

I would like you to focus particularly on the last question.

If we are to be followers of Jesus and to preach the Gospel He preached, what kind of actions should then define our lives today?

The contemporary understanding of Christian discipleship seems to only focus on giving surface level agreement to the preaching of Jesus, but real discipleship requires these things to literally dictate the shape of our lives and the culture in which we live.

- Describe how the people in Luke 4 might have felt hearing this sermon.
- How might Jesus have felt making these bold assertions?
- **Jesus** saw himself as fulfilling the prophetic texts, but what did he actually do? Can you find scripture to evidence this?
- Can you think of how Jesus' ministry would look in our day?
- If the goal of our discipleship is to be like Jesus, what kind of actions then should define OUR lives...today?
